In less than 100 days the 13th European Global Health Conference (ECTMIH) will take place in Utrecht (the Netherlands) from 20-23 November! ECTMIH 2023's theme is 'Shaping the Future of Equitable and Sustainable Planetary Health'.

This event is co-organized by the Dutch and European Societies for Global Health and Tropical Medicine (NVTG, FESTMIH), Dutch Knowledge Centre Global Health (KCGH), UMC Utrecht, and >20 other academic and societal <u>partners</u> from across Europe.

Pre-conference, on **Sunday November 19th the ECTMIH Academy will take place**, with 28 workshops relevant for Global Health and Planetary Health for PhD students, researchers, and practitioners!

After many successful webinars, the next series is coming again this fall. Various interesting topics will be covered.

In September, we will start with the influence of the loss of biodiversity on our physical and mental health. In October, we will delve into the captivating theme of infection prevention, discussing both the useful and less useful aspects of guidelines, and exploring how we can make more sustainable use of gloves. When it comes to sustainability, there is still much ground to cover in the field of medication. In November, we will shed light on this, with subjects such as sustainable contraception and the ecological impact of medications. And finally, our last topic: pediatric medicine. Here, we will delve into topics including climate change and pediatric medicine in general, with special attention to how the climate affects the
